

DUAL ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Dual Enrollment (DE) provides funding for students at eligible high schools to take approved college level coursework for credit towards high school and college graduation requirements.

**Classes can be taken on the college campus or online at the high school.*



ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ Be enrolled in 9th—12th grade at a private/public high school in Georgia or a home study program in GA operated in accordance with O.C.G.A. 20-2-690(c).
- ◆ Be admitted to an eligible, participating Public or Private postsecondary institution as a dual credit enrollment student.
- ◆ Be enrolled in courses listed in the approved DE Course Directory.
- ◆ Maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by the eligible postsecondary institution.

GRADE LEVEL ELIGIBILITY

9th Graders—not eligible

10th Graders

- ◆ may enroll in Career, Technical, & Agricultural Education (CTAE) courses listed in Course Directory at participating TCSG institution only
- ◆ must have a minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT score of 26 on a single test administration & may enroll in any approved courses in directory at a TCSG, USG, or private eligible participating postsecondary institution.

11th & 12th Graders

- ◆ Eligible students may take any approved Dual Enrollment courses listed in the course directory at an eligible participating postsecondary institution (USG, TCSG, or private).

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION OPTION B

High School Graduation Option B offers qualified students a unique path to high school graduation. Students choose to simultaneously earn a high school diploma and a college Associate Degree, Technical Diploma, or two (2) technical certificates of credit (TCCs) in a specific career pathway. Some of the required high school courses may be taken under the state-funded Dual Enrollment program at a technical college.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

- ◆ Meet with school counselor and complete high school application packet
- ◆ Complete college application
- ◆ Attend a parent/student meeting with high school counselor to set up your college schedule, and review high school credits/graduation requirements
- ◆ Set up a GAFutures Account, complete Dual Enrollment online funding application and parent acknowledgement form.
